SUPPLY LIST

Fabrics: 100% cotton, quilt-shop quality fabric. Please, **no flannel** for this project! If you choose any directional fabrics to be used in any of the stars, accent, or background, please add 1/8 yd. to the recommended amount of fabric.

- Center star: 1/8 yd.
 - 3 Light green stars: 1/4 yd.
 - 3 Red stars: 1/4 yd.
 - Yellow accent: 1/4 yd.
 - Cream background: 1/4 yd.
 - Border: 1/2 yd.
 - Backing: 7/8 yd.
 - Binding: 1/4 yd.
 - Batting: 30" x 36"
- **NOTE: you need bring only the fabrics for the top to class.** You need not bring the backing, binding, and batting.

Kit: Includes:

The project set of two acrylic templates for rotary cutting patchwork, Fabric Grips™ for templates, and project pattern.

The kit (see material fee in the class catalogue) will be available for pick-up when you arrive for class, and it is mandatory for each participant.

Other supplies:

- **Notions:** pins, seam ripper, thread snips.
- **Mary Ellen's Best Press Non-Starch Alternative** - do not need to bring to class
- **Neutral color piecing thread:** I prefer Presencia 60 wt. cotton OR Aurifil 50 wt. cotton
- **Rotary cutter:** 28mm size is preferred!
- **Cutting mat:** large cutting mats are provided, however, a rotary cutting mat on a rotating base is very helpful OR a small, non-rotating mat no larger than 12x18" and no smaller than 8x8" will work.
- **"Lead" mechanical pencil AND white chalk mechanical pencil** (Bohin or SewLine)
- **Small flannel-backed plastic table cloth** (no larger than 50 x 70"; no smaller than 35 x 35") OR piece of cotton batting for a design wall (**optional**)

Pre-Workshop Preparation: Please arrive at class with these tasks completed. Thanks!

1. Please "spritz" the fabrics for the top with Mary Ellen's Best Press and press until dry with a dry iron using the cotton setting.
**I use the Mary Ellen's Best Press generously, making sure the fabric is well dampened, but not dripping wet.

2. **Pre-class cutting instructions:**

If you have chosen a directional fabric for any of the stars, accent, or background, please don't cut it until class. I will help you determine the size strip needed to accomplish placing the direction of the print the way that you'd like it in your project.

From each of the star fabrics, accent fabric and background fabric that is NOT directional, please cut the following:

One width-of-fabric strip, 2 1/4" x width-of-fabric. (Approximately 2 1/4" x 42")

Please bring the strips that you've cut AND the remaining fabrics from which you cut them, along with any directional fabrics that you haven't cut to class. You may bring your border fabric to class, though it is not necessary.
